

INSTALLATION INFO

WHEN BUYING:

Call DIGGERS HOTLINE at 1-800-242-8511 to mark your yard for underground utilities. To make sure you can place it where you would like it to be.

Please remember Above ground pools need to be 5ft from underground power and 22.5ft from water level to overhead powerlines. These are the bare minimum so please check with your local municipality.

Check local building codes for requirements of the municipality where the pool is being installed to make sure the pool can be installed.

Building permits are typically required, check with your local municipality

Electrician should be scheduled to install a dedicated circuit and a GFCI breaker after pool installation.

The state of Wisconsin has updated to NEC 2017 electrical code. Wisconsin now requires that above ground pools to be bonded to (reduce voltage gradients in pool area) aka to limit difference in electrical potential across what is near the pool. We do offer Bonding & Trenching as an additional services

When buying a heater check to see If your meter is big enough! Your meter needs to be sized according. Please give WPS or a local Hvac Installer a call ask to verify the size of your gas meter to see if it will support the new gas heater you are purchasing or if you need to update your existing gas meter!

SITE PREP:

Please reroute any down—spouts away from the pool site and away from where the skidsteer or dumptruck will be entering the yard. This will help dry your yard out faster.

Scalping the lawn aka (lowering the deck of the lawn mower all the way down) where the pool is going helps dry the yard up also. go 3-4ft wider than the size of your pool please.

Tarping the site where the pool install is happening before a rainstorm and then removing the tarp after it has rained out will help keep the yard dry. Leaving the tarp on for long periods will have adverse effects.

Doing the 3 items listed above may result in the pool being installed sooner than the expected date.
